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INTRODUCTION

This National Directory and Information is an outcome of the National Council for Persons with Disabilities, Implementation and Strategic Plans 2019 to 2023.

The main purpose of the Directory is to give its users clear referral information on who is doing what and where they are based with complete information of the services available and contacts.

This Directory captured information on service providers for Children with Disabilities, Organizations for Persons with Disabilities, and Non-Government Organization providing services for Persons with Disabilities, Special Schools, Inclusive Schools, and Government Ministries.

PURPOSE OF THIS NATIONAL DIRECTORY AND INFORMATION ON DISABILITY SERVICES

The Strategic Plan of NCPD 2019 -2023, reflects the commitments and priorities for persons with disabilities in Fiji by “**MAKING THE RIGHT REAL**”. This is guided by 10 Objectives and supported with 18 Key Result Areas (KRAs).

Under the KRA 1.3 Establishment of a Community Based Inclusive Development Approach, Strategies is “Care and Rehabilitation of Persons with Disabilities” thus an Activity is to establish a referral mechanism of persons with disabilities for appropriate services.

This Directory gives information to all stakeholders on services available and thus proper referrals can be made, including for persons with disabilities to have the knowledge on the existing resources available.

The social protection programs for Fiji has come a long way with the engagements and input by the disability sector and person with disabilities.

SERVICES

The Department has programs in place to assist persons with disabilities as listed below.

1. Poverty Benefit Scheme (PBS).

This program focuses on families whose livelihood falls below the poverty line. However special consideration is given to families that do not qualify but have a person with disability living in the family. They can qualify for financial assistance on a monthly basis.

2. Care and Protection Program (CP).

This program is for single mothers, deserted spouses, and dependents of prisoners and for children under the age of 18 who live with a foster care family. This program can also be used for families that look after children with disabilities and also for families that have a child with a disability with parents in the family.

3. Bus Fare Concession

Transport concessions to persons with disabilities are limited to buses and taxis only. Bus fares are free to all persons with disabilities and 20% discount on taxis provided they have a Transport concession card.

Requirements for issue of transport concession card:

- A copy of birth certificate
- Two passport size photos
- Support Letter from the National Council for Persons with Disabilities (NCPD) respective DPOs or Special school and etc.
- Form for Bus fare concession from the Social Welfare office.

4. Disability Allowance Scheme

The scheme targets persons who are permanently disabled. This scheme is only eligible for Fiji Residents who are residing in Fiji at the time of application

Referrals can be made to any Social welfare office. The scheme requires face to face interaction with applicants.

5. Social Pension Scheme (SPS)

Eligible for Fiji Citizen (resides in Fiji who are 65 years of age and has not benefited from FNPf or another pension scheme)

6. Housing Assistance

Refer cases which is verified by Welfare Officer on the ground to be submitted to the Housing Sub Committee.

7. Other services

The Department also works in collaboration with other NGOs and Government in assisting people with disabilities. This includes writing support letters, facilitating provision of walking aids or assistive devices, training in income generation, support to run small business, and support to finding appropriate homes.

8. Institutions

There are 10 institutions for children under the approval of the Department in Fiji. Children in the institutions are given monthly allowance of \$100 each.

All enquiries can be directed to the Senior Social Welfare Officers or any Social Welfare Officer in the districts.

MINISTRY OF HEALTH & MEDICAL SERVICES

All persons with disabilities who require referral services will require medical reports. Enquiries can be made at local health centers in your areas.

There are also Community Rehabilitation Assistants available in all districts that can assist with the rehabilitation of family members who have a disability.

1. **Health services** for Persons with Disabilities are referred to the local health centers in their areas.
2. **National Rehabilitation Medicine** is based at Tamavua Hospital in Suva and cases from around the Country for rehabilitation are referred there.
3. **Community Rehabilitation Assistance** is based at health centers and work in the community with zone nurses to conduct home visits and train caregivers on daily care living skills.
Community Rehabilitation Assistants (CRA) are also based at sub divisional health centers in Fiji.

Services provided by the Community Rehabilitation Assistants (CRA) include:

- Health promotion and disability prevention.
 - Early identification (of at-risk cases and potentially disabling conditions).
 - Intervention or rehabilitation.
 - Management of cases.
 - Follow up home visits after discharge from hospital for assessment, therapy, education, training and counselling.
 - Facilitation of referrals to other services such as pediatricians, medical officers, schools, Social welfare, mobility devices, prosthetics and orthotics
 - Facilitate provision and construction of equipment, rehabilitation aids and toys.
4. **Orthotics and Prosthetic** Laboratory is based at the Tamavua Hospital where Prosthetic limbs are made for amputees and those with physical disabilities.
 5. **Mental Health** – St Giles is the Mental Health Care Hospital where cases of mental illness are referred and those affected are treated and hospitalized there for treatment and are also taught skills programs for self-sustainability or employment.
 6. **Fiji Albinism Projects** under the Ministry for Health. Its Project Office is based at the Department of Dermatology in Tamavua, Twomey Hospital.

MINISTRY OF EDUCATION

The Ministry of Education has 15 Special schools and 2 vocational training centers around Fiji specifically for children with severe disabilities or special needs.

Services Provided:

- Advises Ministry of Education on issues regarding special and inclusive education.
- Coordinates and monitors school activities in special/inclusive schools.
- Organizes and provides capacity development for teachers of the special/inclusive schools.

Special schools enroll children with moderate to severe disabilities or special needs. All the special schools are registered under the primary section of the Ministry of Education.

Requirements for enrolment:

- Medical Report from doctor confirming child's disability.
- Birth certificate.
- Clearance letter from previous school.

Most of the special schools offer specialist services such as physiotherapy, occupational therapy and speech therapy.

There is also flexibility in teaching and learning and there is one to one assistance or support given for students. All special schools participate in extra curricula activities such as sports and dance

District Education Offices

District Education Officers can assist in finding a school for your child. The contact people at all District Education offices are the Senior Education Officers or any education officer within the District Office. They can also facilitate enrolment of children with disabilities or special needs into schools.

There are nine district education offices in the country and are centrally located in 9 major towns.


